Purpose

Hypospadias is a common anomaly and hypospadias surgery is considered to be an index operation in pediatric urology. The sheer versatility of the anomaly and the staggering number of surgical techniques described in literature is enough to confuse surgeon young interested hypospadias surgery. This course is aimed at appraising the young surgeons about the basics of hypospadias surgery, with a special emphasis on the choice of operative techniques to achieve optimal results. An overview of the common techniques used in hypospadiology will also be discussed and demonstrated
